PORT-BASED OUTREACH: Saving endangered species from bycatch in Pacific Fisheries

BirdLife Pacific in partnership with SPREP have been undertaking a port-based outreach programme in Suva with surface long line vessels fishing for tuna. The programme aims to bridge the implementation gap between regional and government regulations requiring use of bycatch mitigation on fishing vessels and practical application of the mitigation by skippers and crew to prevent bycatch of species of special interest such as seabirds and turtles.
